ORDER

THIS APPLICATION, for orders compelling the production of information from the respondent, Cameron Robins o/a The One and Only Pranks and Stickers [**“Respondent”**], to assist the applicant, Douglas Judson [**“Applicant”**], to locate and identify the unknown respondent, John Doe [**“Doe”**] (who is a customer of the Respondent), and for ancillary relief relating to service, was heard this 26th day of February, 2026, via Zoom conference.

ON READING the Notice of Application, issued February 18, 2026, and the Affidavit of Douglas William Judson, affirmed February 18, 2026 [together, **“Applicant’s Materials”**], and email correspondence from counsel for the Respondent confirming he takes no position on the relief sought; and

ON HEARING the submissions of counsel for the Applicant:

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that service of the Applicant's Materials on the Respondent, via email to support@theoneandonly.ca, by the applicant, Douglas Judson ["**Applicant**"], is validated as having been effective as of February 20, 2026.
2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Applicant may serve any further materials on the Respondent by transmitting them via email to support@theoneandonly.ca until such time as the Respondent may provide a different email address for service or becomes represented by a lawyer.
3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Applicant shall serve a copy of this issued order on the Respondent in accordance with the previous paragraph and shall file proof of service of same with the court forthwith.
4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that upon being served with a copy of this order, the Respondent shall, within seven (7) days, produce to the Applicant, via email, and to the extent such information and documents are available:
 - a. The name, address(es), phone number(s), and email address(es) of Doe;
 - b. A copy of the purchase/order placed with the Respondent by Doe;
 - c. Copies of all written correspondence between the Respondent and Doe;
 - d. A copy of the payment and transaction record for the processing of Doe's payment to the Respondent in relation to Doe's purchase from the Respondent; and
 - e. The web and telecommunications data associated with Doe's communications or order placement with the Respondent, including the

relevant IP address, source port, and other technological data associated with such correspondence and purchase.

5. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Applicant may return this application before a judge, with further affidavit evidence, if further orders are required to identify or locate Doe.
