**ORDER**

**THIS MOTION**, made by the plaintiffs, for an order compelling the attendance of the defendant at an examination in aid of execution and for the ability to pursue further relief should he fail to do so, was heard at the courthouse in Ottawa this 22nd day of January, 2026 by videoconference.

**ON READING** the Notice of Motion, dated September 30, 2025, the Affidavit of Katelynn Rookes, affirmed September 30, 2025, the Transcript of the

Examination, dated September 23, 2025, the Reasons on Application of Newton RSJ, dated November 28, 2025 and cited as 2025 ONSC 6689, and

**ON HEARING** the submissions of the plaintiff (represented by counsel) and the defendant (acting in person), and upon the court dismissing the defendant's motion to set aside default judgment in this action,

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the defendant shall attend an examination in aid of execution, via Zoom conference, at the date and on the time specified by the plaintiffs in their Notice of Examination, with such date to be no sooner than seven (7) days after service of the Notice of Examination on the defendant.

2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Notice of Examination in respect of the examination described in the previous paragraph shall be served on the defendant by email, sent to [scottieblackwell@yahoo.ca](mailto:scottieblackwell@yahoo.ca), with a copy to follow by regular mail, to 165 Kriese Road, Kelowna, British Columbia, V1X 4Y2, and that the plaintiffs shall file proof of service with the court.

3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the defendant shall transmit to counsel for the plaintiffs, via email, in advance of the examination described above, all of the information, documents, and materials listed in the Notice of Examination.

4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that should the defendant fail to attend the examination in aid of execution, fail to deliver the items set out in the Notice of Examination, fail to swear or affirm to tell the truth at the examination, or fail to attend the examination from a suitable location or to appear on video for the

examination, this motion be returned before a judge, on notice to the defendant, for the plaintiffs to request further orders, including to request findings of contempt or to seek enforcement in British Columbia.

5. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the defendant shall pay to the the costs of this motion and of the motion to set aside the default judgment fixed at \$9,500.00 inclusive of HST.
